Public Participation - Budget Priorities

Each year, the Northeastern Catholic District School Board invites its stakeholders, committee members, and staff to engage in a process of consultation relating to the establishment of Budget considerations and priorities. The Board of Trustees and Director's Leadership Team believe that this process provides a wide-range of information for consideration as we work together to establish the Budget Estimates moving into the next school year.

The Board of Trustees reviewed the consultation received throughout the month of February 2025. The Trustees discussed what feedback resonated most with them and also had an opportunity to identify other priority areas that may not have been addressed through the public participation process.

The review of consultation and Trustee discussion helped to identify patterns, trends, and possibilities to consider in the development of the Budget Estimates for 2025-2026. A summary report will be shared with NCDSB stakeholders in accordance with Policy T-10 Public Participation.
